One of the many things I learnt from feminism is that there is an alternative to the either/or dichotomy and we can walk a both/and path that can hold very different views together in creative tension. This is not akin to sitting on the fence but is an active and difficult path that listens to both sides of the story and carefully negotiates a middle way.
